ARRIVAL REMINDER – PLEASE BE ON TIME!

- Students **must arrive by 8:45 AM** and be settled in class by 8:50 AM.
- Students arriving after 8:45 AM must use the Main Entrance and will be marked late.
- GATE F (vehicle drop-off) closes at 8:45 AM.
- GATE B (K–2) and GATE D (3–4) are for walkers and those parking and walking.

Interlake School Division Guidelines

- Temperature/Windchill of -30° C or lower = indoor activity
- Temperature/Windchill of -25° C to -29° C = outdoor activity for fifteen minutes (15) maximum
